LITERACY AND NUMERACY

Our R-6 School is a highly regarded for its learning program. We emphasise Literacy and Numeracy across all curriculum areas with intervention programs that help all learners. These include:

- a daily literacy block of 100 minutes,
- specialist support time in every class,
- small group learning and explicit skills teaching,
- connection to life experiences,
- regular monitoring and assessment of learning,
- reporting to parents twice a year,
- extensive leadership and student voice opportunities,
- extension programs for high achieving students,
- extensive use of ICTS and performing arts,
- specialist programs in sports and physical education, and Indonesian language and culture.

Students learn problem-solving, decision-making, co-operation and effective communication to assist them to become 21st century learners.

TRANSITION

We maintain close links with community kindergartens. Continuity of learning visits occur throughout the year, with transition visits beginning in term 4.

Before they begin, students attend the school several times to meet teachers and familiarise themselves with school routines and environment.
